



Funding Guidelines for the Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund (Municipality/Organization Application)

Who is eligible for funding?

New Brunswick communities/organizations looking to aid those living with a permanent disability are eligible to apply to *The Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund*.

What activities will be funded?

For the purposes of this fund, activities will be considered if they reflect physical activities that work toward achieving the guidelines of maintaining a healthy lifestyle as outlined by the Public Health Agency of Canada. Examples of appropriate funding requests include; reducing program expenses, equipment needs, transportation expenses, and/or facility upgrades.

Applicants can request funding for any expenses that impede one's ability to implement or maintain a healthy lifestyle. The Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund Selection Committee will review all applications and allocate funding to those requests that best reflect a long-term commitment toward improving access to active living.

When will funding be allocated?

The Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund application must be submitted by July 8th, 2016. If funding remains after this period, the Selection Committee will reallocate the remaining funds to the October 7th / January 20th review periods. A total of \$2500 will be made available for review. Requests will **not exceed \$2500**. If the criteria is not met or requested during a funding period, it will be deferred to the next funding period. If there are unused funds in the October period, they will be reallocated to the Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund Individual applications.

What is the application process?

An application form is available at Recreation New Brunswick (www.recreationnb.ca). Requests will be reviewed by the Inclusive Recreation Activity Fund Selection Committee. Priority will be given to first time applicants. Any and all funds that are allocated will be made payable only to the facilitator or supplier of the approved activity.

Note: All applications must be accompanied by a letter of intent detailing how these funds will be used and the benefit to your community/organization.
